Every day, thousands of pounds of food product are saved from becoming waste thanks to Feeding America Southwest Virginia's Prepared & Perishables program. Product that local food sources would otherwise be forced to discard are picked up by the Food Bank and its local partner agencies and distributed free of charge to less fortunate individuals in our communities.

Over 150,000 individuals in Southwest Virginia are classified as food insecure. Since we accept safe, consumable food that you might normally be forced to discard, supporting these neighbors is an easy investment in the social and economic strength of our community.
